Simon Fischer P7440 \$59.95

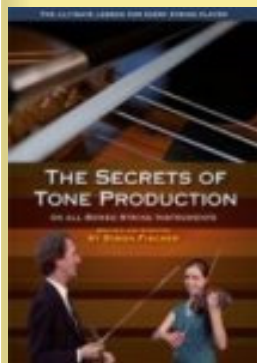

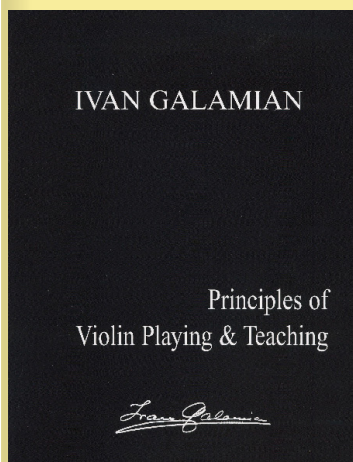
